### 1. Reminders from Ana Claire – Wrenn Combs

- It is a privilege to be in a production.
- It is **imperative** that your child/children attend all rehearsals.
- If any student misses more than one **rehearsal** she/he may be dismissed from the cast, especially if it is a double cast role.
- It is essential that dancers be on time to rehearsals!
- Double Cast Students – Cast A or B (2 shows at Macky & 1 in Longmont). Students will find out which cast they are in after the first rehearsal.
- Student cast assignments are posted on our website.
- Be sure to check the rehearsal schedule on Thursday every week to know whether there are changes. Parents and students will *not* get emails when there are updates to the schedule, so you will want to make it a habit to look for yourselves.

### 2. Performance Fee – Wrenn Combs

- Cost is \$150 per student; no credit cards please. Make checks out to Boulder Ballet.
- Your payment is due now. If you have not turned that in yet, please do so today or next week without fail! Please include your child's name in the memo on your check.

### 3. Boulder Ballet Nutcracker Tickets – Shelley Sampson from Boulder Philharmonic

- Corps de ballet family discounted tickets will be sold only to families with students in the Nutcracker 2018 cast and only for the Boulder performances.
- Discounted tickets will be available September 10 through October 10.
- Discount is 30% off any ticket purchased during the dates stated above.
- Tickets must be purchased through the Boulder Philharmonic Orchestra's Box Office. Please call Shelley at 303-449-1343 Monday – Friday from 11AM – 4PM. If you get the answering machine, please leave a brief message with your name and contact information only; Shelley will get back to you as soon as she possibly can.

### 4. Nutcracker School Sales – Mihail Codrescu

- Ticket sales through schools will run from Oct. 1– Nov. 5 only. All sales generated should be turned in to Beth at the Boulder Ballet office.

- After you have emailed Mihail and signed up, you will talk to the school's PTO about the opportunity for the school to receive 20% of the ticket sales generated by this promotion of dance and music. Mihail can help you with the details of your presentation to the PTO.
- Start the process of getting approval from the PTO as soon as you can so you have more time for families to buy tickets, increasing the benefit to the school.
- Information about last year's sales will be included in this year's program.

- Boulder – Macky dress rehearsals: Cast A on Tues., Nov. 20 (Cast B will sit in audience to note spacing, stage directions, and any changes that may occur) and Cast B on Wed., Nov. 21 (Cast A will sit in audience to note spacing, stage directions, and any changes that may occur.)
- Boulder – Macky Auditorium (4 performances): Cast A will perform Fri., Nov. 23 at 2:00pm, and Sat., Nov. 24 at 2:00pm; Cast B will perform Sat., Nov. 24 at 7:00pm, and Sun., Nov 25 at 2:00pm.
- Longmont – Vance Brand dress rehearsals: Cast B on Thurs., Nov. 29, (Cast A will sit in audience to note spacing, stage directions, and any changes that may occur) and Cast A on Fri., Nov. 30 (Cast B will sit in audience to note spacing, stage directions, and any changes that may occur)
- Longmont – Vance Brand Auditorium (2 performances): Cast B will perform Sat., Dec. 1, at 4:00pm; Cast A will perform Sun., Dec. 2, at 2:00pm.
- Gentle Nutcracker – Sat., Dec. 1, 1 pm – “Land of the Sweets” – 2<sup>nd</sup> act. Cast TBD.

## 6. Costumes and Volunteering – Jennifer Saal Costume Assistant, volunteer coordinator

Parents with a dancer(s) in the Nutcracker are expected to volunteer for a minimum of two shifts per family over the duration of dress rehearsals and/or performances of the shows. If you are unable to do so, you will be asked to pay an additional fee of \$150. Volunteer sign up will be sent out by Jen or Erica in the costume shop.

- Fitting Schedule** – We hope to begin fittings next weekend. We will do our best to avoid schedule conflicts but, we also need a commitment from you to have all dancers attend the designated fitting in order to provide the best results. Occasionally, we will need to have multiple fittings for a certain role.
- Sign Up Genius** – Each family is required to sign up for at least two positions in order to fulfill the contract we all signed during Nutcracker auditions.
- Costume/Hair**- Boulder ballet provides the main costume for each role. Families will need to provide additional pieces. For example, pink ballet flats. This email will explain what each dancer needs to provide as well as hair placement.
- Transition to Macky** – This email will discuss everything from where to park to how to pick up your child. It will also, have important information about expectations for your dancer.
- Transition to Longmont**- Very similar to the Macky email.

**Parent Expectations** – Parents are *not* allowed in the dressing rooms. I know this maybe a little scary for first time Nutcracker families but, this is a wonderful experience for your children to grow as dancers and rely on their “Boulder Ballet” family for assistance.

**Hair and makeup workshop** – September 18<sup>th</sup> 4:00 pm to 5:00 pm. Amy and Becky will be in the costume shop to teach parents and dancers how to make the perfect bun or get stage ready for a performance.
